Policy Title: Maintenance of Orderly Conduct in Shelter Care and Detention Care Programs Code No. 503

Policy Statement

Students have the responsibility to participate and contribute to a respectful and orderly environment conducive to learning and to comply with behavior expectations communicated to them.

Scope of Policy

This policy applies to all children and students served by Heartland AEA personnel in shelter, detention, and correctional facilities.

Accountability Overview

- Heartland AEA will utilize a framework of positive behavior interventions and supports for students in shelter and correctional facilities.-The framework will be communicated to students during intake.
- Heartland AEA will follow the guidance of the Crisis Prevention Institute (CPI) and Chapter 103 of the Iowa Code regulating timeout, seclusion, and restraint of students.
