Policy Title: Internet Acceptable Use and Safety Code No. 505

Policy Statement

Heartland AEA protects the online safety of students by imposing strict controls to prevent unauthorized access and other unlawful activities by users online, including unauthorized disclosure of or access to sensitive information.

Scope of Policy

This policy applies to all students using technology infrastructure, hardware and software provided by Heartland AEA.

Accountability Overview

Students supervised directly by Heartland AEA staff receive instruction on the acceptable use of technology policy and are required to acknowledge their understanding and agreement of the policy through their signature.

Parents, guardians, and/or staff serving in *loco parentis* of students housed in juvenile homes or correctional facilities are notified that students are provided supervised access to the Internet and have access to the Acceptable Use of Technology policy students are required to sign.

Heartland AEA complies with the provisions of the Children's Internet Protection Act of 2001.
