About E-Rate:

The Schools and Libraries (E-rate) Program provides discounts to assist eligible schools and libraries in order to obtain affordable internet access and telecommunications services. E-rate funds the following service types: Data Transmission Services and/or Internet Access, Internal Connections, Managed Internal Broadband Services, and Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections. Discounts range from 20-90% of the costs of eligible services, depending on the level of poverty and the urban/rural status at the school district level.

Service Description:

The E-rate application process is complex. Many school districts elect to engage a consultant to manage the process, record keeping bidding, and budget. Iowa AEA has highly skilled E-rate experts who can manage the process from start to finish. Iowa AEA provides a cost-effective consulting option.
