



AEA Technology Services: Technology Health Check Ups

Service Description:

Iowa AEA Technology Services offers a comprehensive technology audit. The audit process includes an on-premise inspection of the district's technology infrastructure including the Data Network, Information Systems, Data Privacy & Security, Client Devices, Data Center, and E-Rate Program. The technology audit focuses on technology infrastructure, procedures, and policies.

Service Model:

The AEA will engage in the on-premise inspection of the district's technology infrastructure alongside the district Superintendent, Technology Director/Coordinator, and/or designee.

Costs:

Technology Health Check-up Service – \$500.

The fee may be paid in full or used as a credit toward an additional AEA Technology Service of equal or greater value within 30 days of the delivery of the report, Technology Health Check-up Results and Considerations. If the district chooses to utilize the credit toward another AEA Technology Service, services must be utilized by the end of the
